
Gookie Thief A Fluency

Print all game pages. To create a game logo on the back of the playing cards, print page 19 on the backs of pages 2 through 18.

Laminate pages.

Cut pages into fours. Now you're ready to play!

GAME DIRECTIONS:

To play, students take turns drawing a game card. If a student draws a game card with a fluency sentence on it, he or she reads the sentence. If the sentence is read correctly, the student keeps the card. If the sentence is not read correctly, the student places the card back in the card pile.

If a student draws a BONUS COOKIE! card, he or she gets an extra turn.

Watch out for THIEF! cards.

If a student draws a

be instructed to put some of
their cards back!

At the end of playing time, the student with the most cards wins!




Someone stole 3 cookies from your cookie jar! Put 3 cards back!





Put I card back.




Someone stole 3 cookies from your cookie jar! Put 3 cards back!
